Notes to the Financial Statements

1. Nature of operations

The Seymour Salmonid Society ("the Society") was incorporated on May 4, 1988 as a non-profit Society.

The purposes of the Society are the promotion and encouragement (on the North Shore of Burrard Inlet and its environ) of knowledge and interest in the preservation, development and enhancement of salmon and other fish species native to the area. Furthermore:

- to establish, coordinate and operate fish enhancement program;
- to encourage proper management of the fisheries resource;
- to provide an educational base for a diversity of resource users; and
- to increase public awareness of the need and benefits of the salmonid resources of British Columbia.
